PRAYERS

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Josphat Rutto, Member for Soin Ward): Welcome honorable members to this afternoon session after the long recess. Order number one!

COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHAIR

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Josphat Rutto, Member for Soin Ward): Honorable members, we have a communication from the chairperson in charge Budget and Appropriation Committee requesting members of the committee to go through the schedules in the programs of their wards in the Budget.

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STATEMENTS

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Josphat Rutto, Member for Soin Ward): Honorable members, we have just come from the long recess and I know most of us here are planning to vie for various seats during the 2022 general election. The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Josphat Rutto, Member for Soin Ward): Thank you. Honorable Cheruiyot Bett!

Hon. Cheruiyot Bett (Member for Ainamoi Ward): Thank you very much Mr. Speaker for giving an opportunity to also join my colleagues in welcoming members to the sixth session of the County Assembly. It has been long since we were here. The whole of December and January we were at home and that is why today we are very fresh. I want to appeal to all the Honorable members that we may not have any other recess because I think the other recess that is coming shall be from June to the time the general election will be done. The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Josphat Rutto, Member for Soin Ward): Thank you Honorable Cheruiyot Bett, honorable Grace Betty?

Hon. Grace Betty Koech (Nominated Member representing Women): Thank you honorable Speaker for giving me an opportunity to rise and make some few observations. First I really want to thank God for keeping all of us safe while we were out on recess for the last two months. Secondly I want to say that this is a campaign season, a very serious one and I am making a prayer to each and every one of us. I don't want to repeat what the others have said, my prayer to this honorable members those who are in as we go out to align ourselves now to our preferred candidates. As I conclude, I want to thank God for giving us this opportunity, it is our prayer that this time many ladies will be elected because this time those of who were representing the women, it is very unfortunate that we are leaving this House having done nothing, no budgetary allocation, nothing being

Hon. Cheruiyot Bett (Member for Ainamoi Ward): Point of Order!

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Josphat Rutto, Member for Soin Ward): Yes Hon. Cheruiyot Bett!

Hon. Cheruiyot Bett (Member for Ainamoi Ward): In fact the honorable member is misleading because you are member of County Assembly and you know what we have done to the women of this county you! You know it for a fact so the honorable by purporting that we have done nothing you know the word nothing Mr. Speaker!

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Josphat Rutto, Member for Soin Ward): Thank you Hon. Cheruiyot Bett. Actually Hon. Grace Betty, you know that when we do our budget in Kericho County especially when it comes to bursaries, roads, health, it touches all women, men and also our children so it cuts across. Maybe you should have said you were not allocated some percentage to your side but not nothing, you withdraw that word nothing.

Hon. Grace Betty Koech (Nominated Member representing Women): Ok. Honorable Speaker sir, my point was on gender mainstreaming. When I say there was no budgetary allocation for gender mainstreaming, that is what I meant. I am not saying that there was no budgetary allocation. All the budgetary allocation were done on roads, water, hospitals and all that touches on them, but there was no allocation specifically to tackle their issues and to improve on their areas! That is what I meant otherwise I didn't mean to hurt anybody.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Josphat Rutto, Member for Soin Ward): Honorable member the only word that I want you to withdraw is the word nothing.

Hon. Grace Betty Koech (Nominated Member representing Women): Okay. I withdraw the word nothing but I am saying specially improving their businesses and on their lives.

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The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Josphat Rutto, Member for Soin Ward): Thank you honorable Grace Betty now I am getting you clearly. Honorable members I'm seeing that may be we were warming this House. You know it has been so long since we met and you know that actually we are feeling that the nomination period will come and we need also to exercise as you talk to your various electorates. At least this is the place also where you practice well. So I want to thank you all honorable members for actually welcoming each and every one to this House after the long recess.
